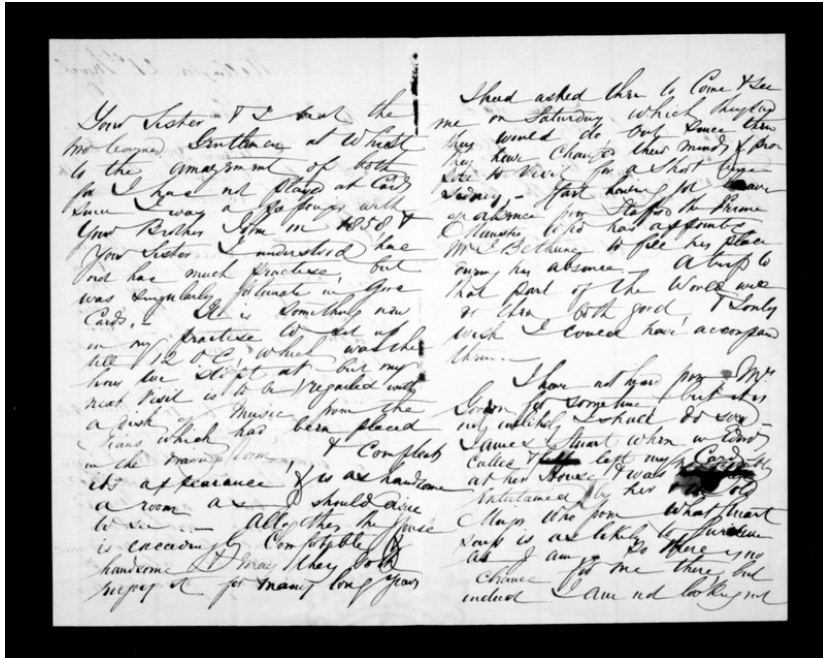
My Dear Mr. Lean,
