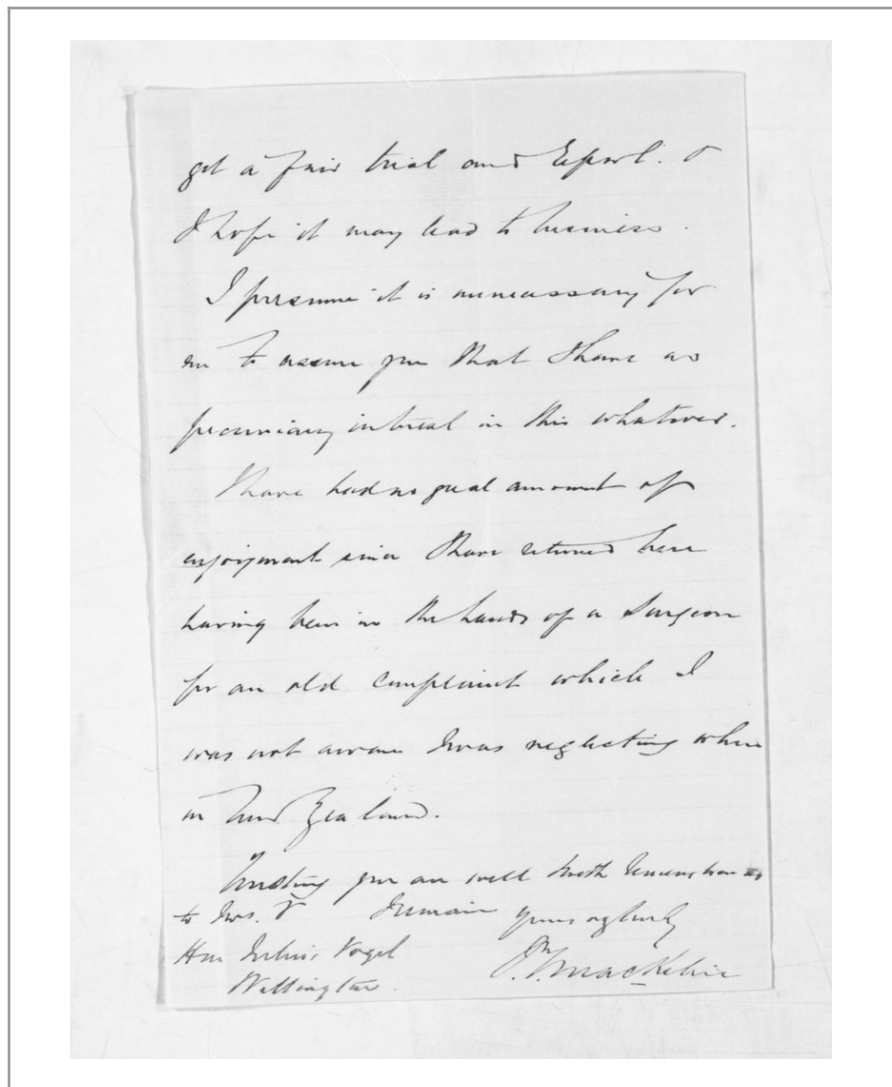


London 26 June 1872.
