My dear Sir Donald

I have been unable  
to start to get as far as your  
house, & to-day find my  
rheumatism so bad that  
I think it would be imprudent  
to go out for fear of disabling

dear illness but was glad  
what relief Douglas's  
telegram - and I hope from  
what I have heard since  
I arrived. that you will  
very soon be all right again.
