This morning's papers say you have gone to Wanganui in consequence  
 of the return to Waitotara. There is a report in Waitotara that *Koro*  
*has slipped through & joined Sirs, but I do not credit it. Preece I have*  
*tried to examine the Hingoes near Horomanga where Kereopa gave information*  
*Koro is concealed. There nothing fresh since I wrote by the Wellington -*  
*all going on well and getting through the work. I hope to get away*  
*end of this month to Wanganui - leaving for the Bay of Islands presently*  
*of course I shall hear what you find the state of things on West*  
 Coast - Remember me to Fox - He is with you -
