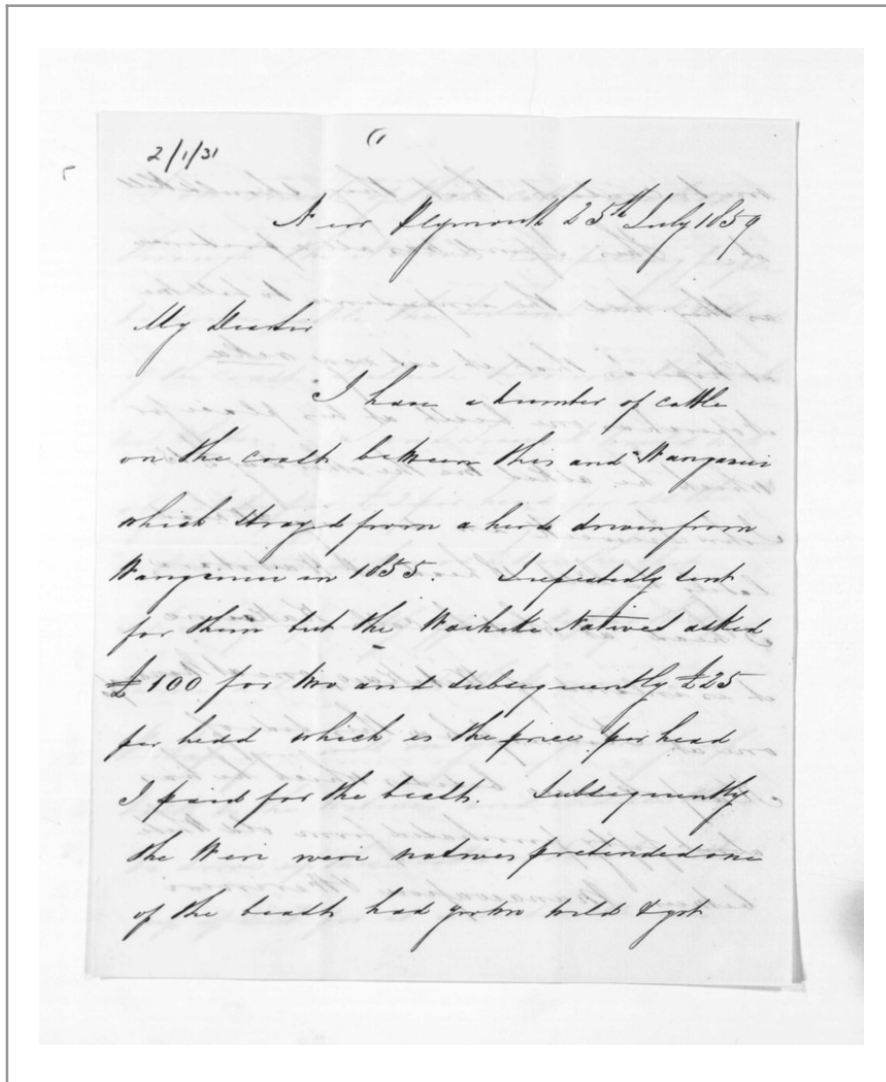

It is my wish of white cattle are both  
through the natives compelling people  
to drive cattle the inland road instead  
of the coast I allude to mine & I would  
not think. I am sure would not  
object to pay £2 per head for all the  
cattle delivered here or £1 on the spot  
I have frequently offered to pay that for  
same delivered at the tomorrow.  
Perhaps you will on your journey up  
talk to the natives and induce them  
to drive up their cattle or to deliver them  
up of land for at a reasonable rate
