As a further reply to the  
deputation which waited on Lord  
Palmerston on the 18<sup>th</sup> Instant.  
I am desired by His Lordship to  
inform you that One Regiment  
has already gone to New Zealand  
and that another is going to  
relieve the one previously there,  
while the Regiment which is to be  
relieved, may, of course, be  
detained in the country for  
a time, if it be urgently  
necessary.
