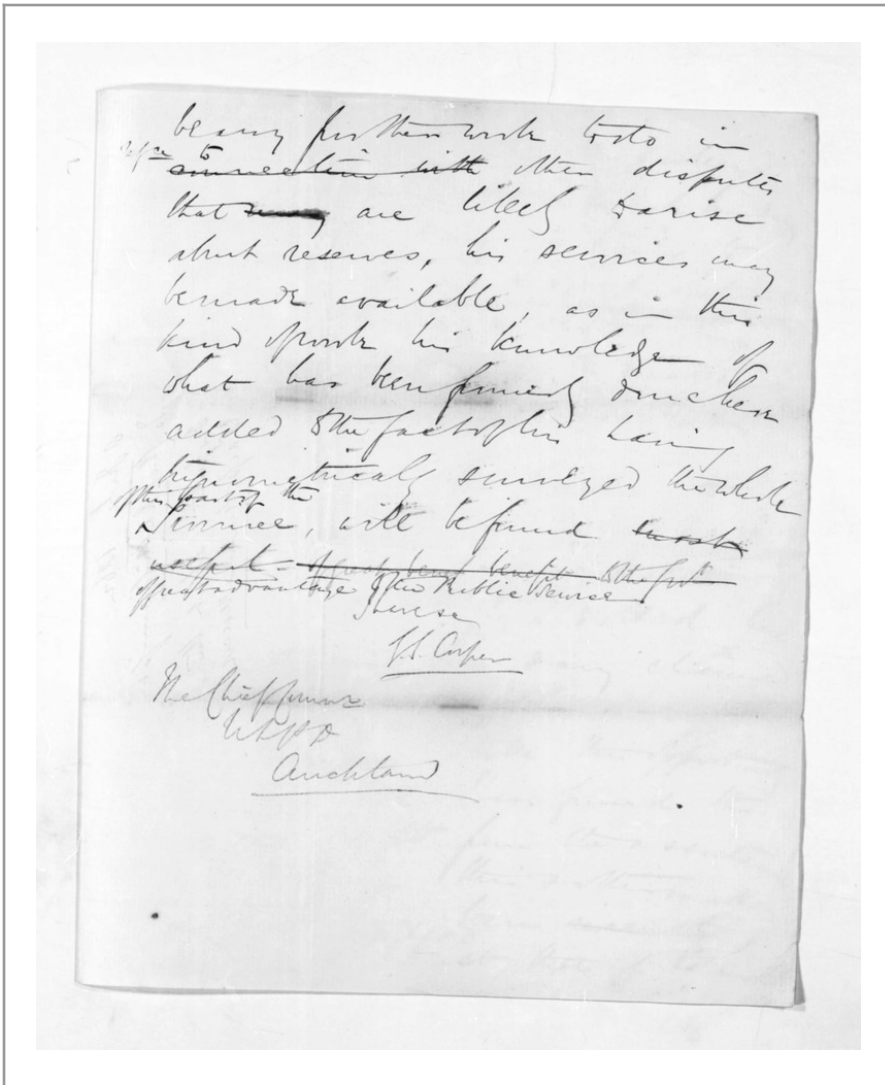
I could not tell Hapū
