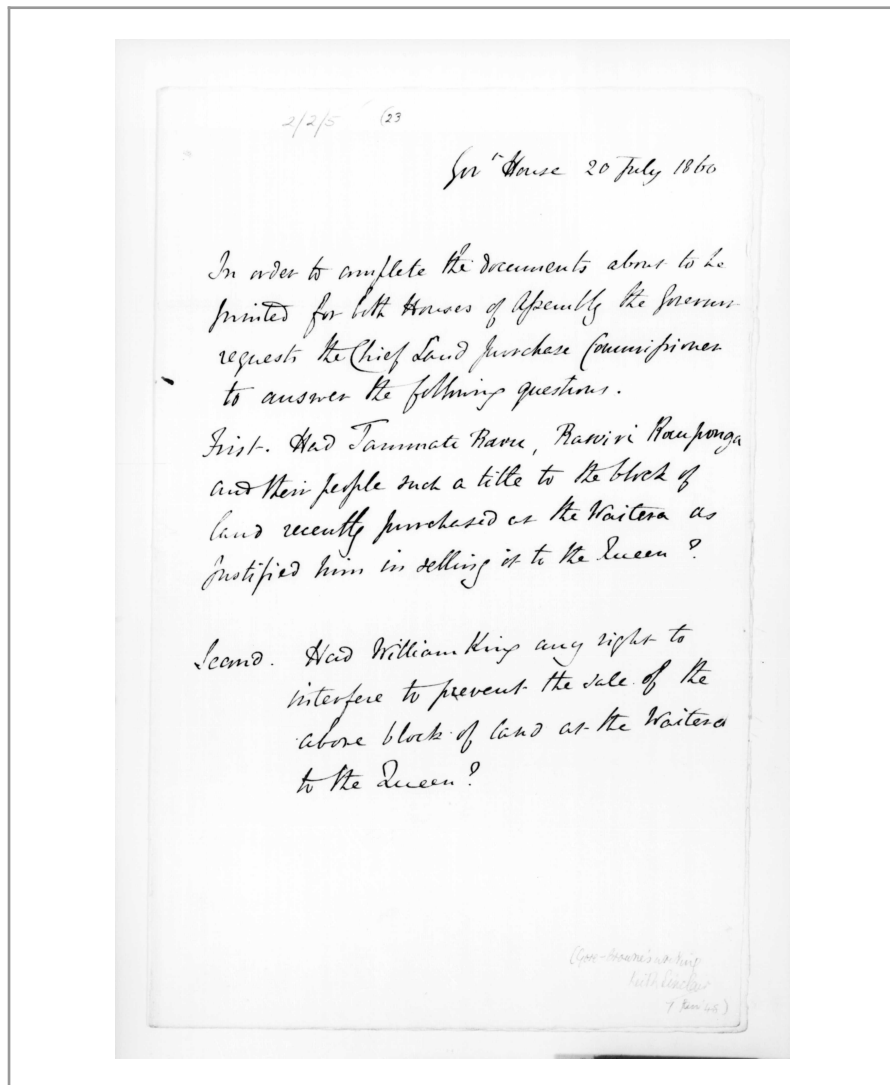

In order to complete the documents about to be printed for both Houses of Assembly the Governor requests the Chief Land Purchase Commissioner to answer the following questions.

First. Had Tamamata Hame, Rariri Raupunga and their people such a title to the block of land recently purchased at the Waikato as justified him in selling it to the Queen?

Second. Had William King any right to interfere to prevent the sale of the above block of land at the Waikato to the Queen?
