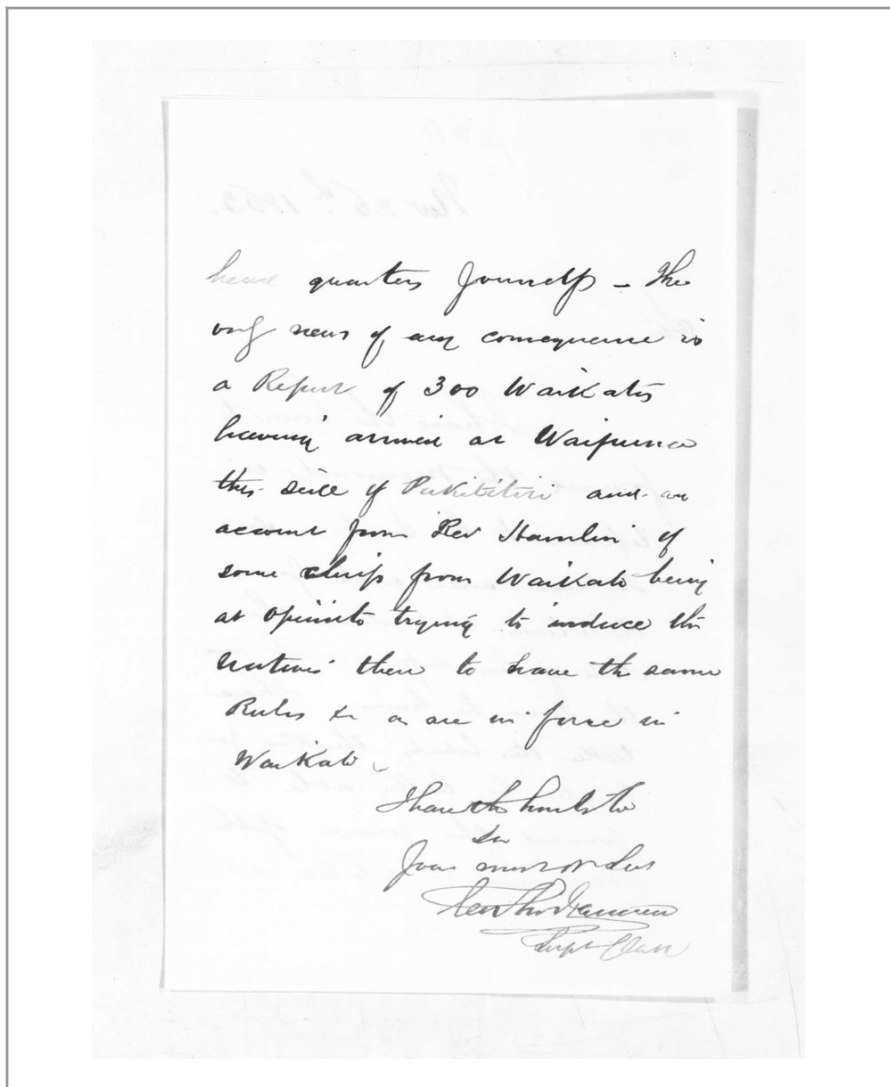

Hamlin of some chiefs from Waikato being at Opunoto trying to induce the natives there to have the same Rules etc. as are in force in Waikato.
