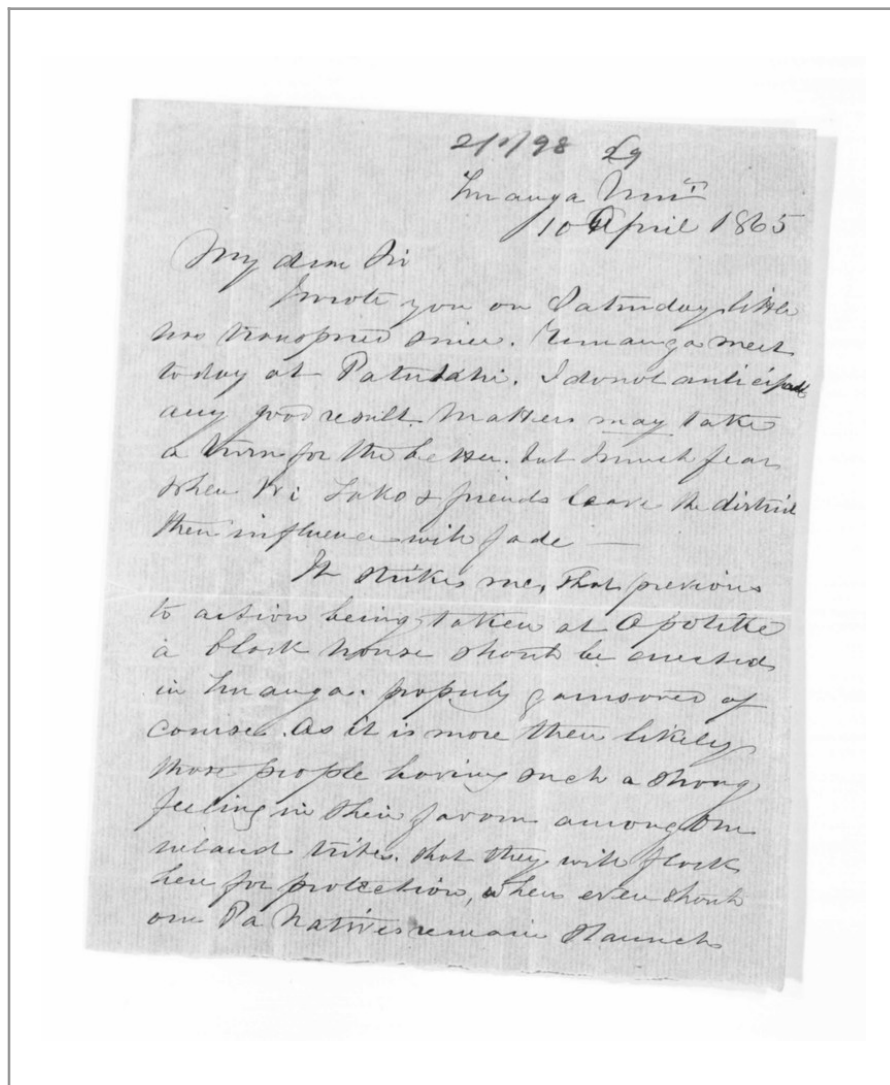


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which I am doubtful, they might

 I would in the latter plan to
 have arms on board the Hercules in order
 that we might have them to fall back
 on should the circumstances alter. I say that
 we ought to be enabled to assist those natives
 who might take up arms in our
 defence. Further if the natives
 do not take a decided stand by sending
 Neruwa and his gang out of the
 district, it is more than probable
 that we shall have to take them into
 a decided resolution in favour of the
 rebels. We should then be forced in a very
 great measure. If the present natives
 will consent to work or can you empower
 me to ensure the success of the
 work however through I should feel
 without help of men, we should not
 make much progress, however

If you can empower me to send out
 to get notices to erect and remove
 some stone of paper. Further I will
 be pleased to give you an authority
 (Capt. P. H. or his Agent in the
 name of the Government) to the
 Post and all others are intended
 to detain any ~~day~~ ^{day} ~~of~~ ^{of} the
 arrival should it be necessary
 to cause the landing letter
 to be added as they state on
 or an English.

We have arranged with
 Messrs P. H. & Co. to be
 ready. Could the importation of spirits
 be started? It really is shameful

 in my view among our natives may
 feel that they are under the present existing
 circumstances.
