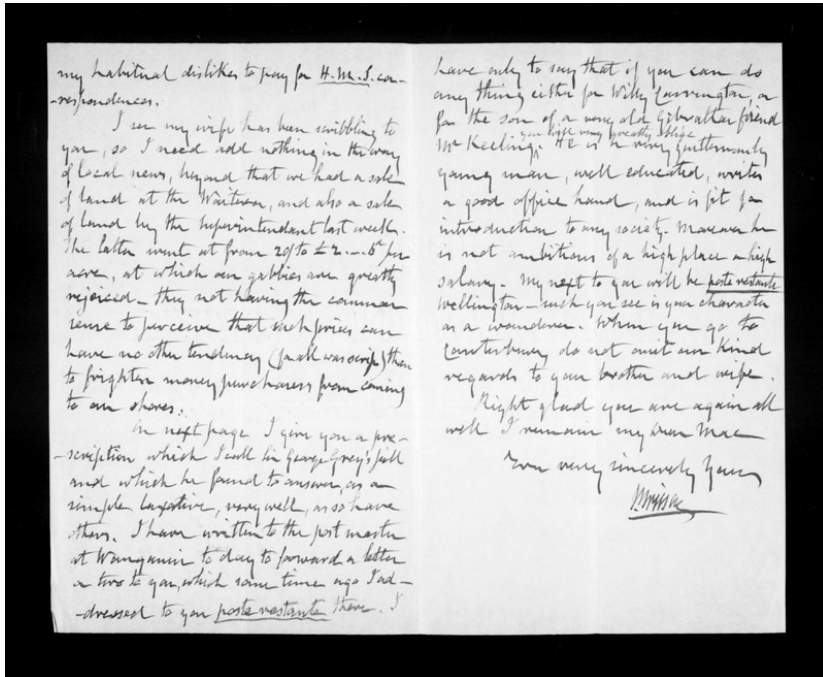

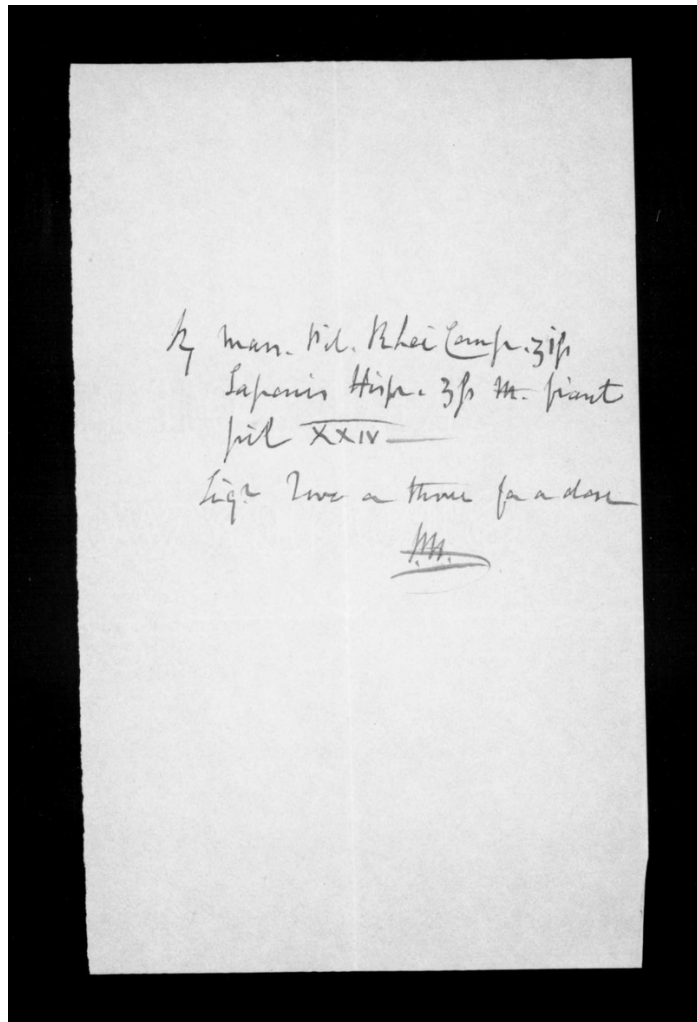

but which I have not. It is one of

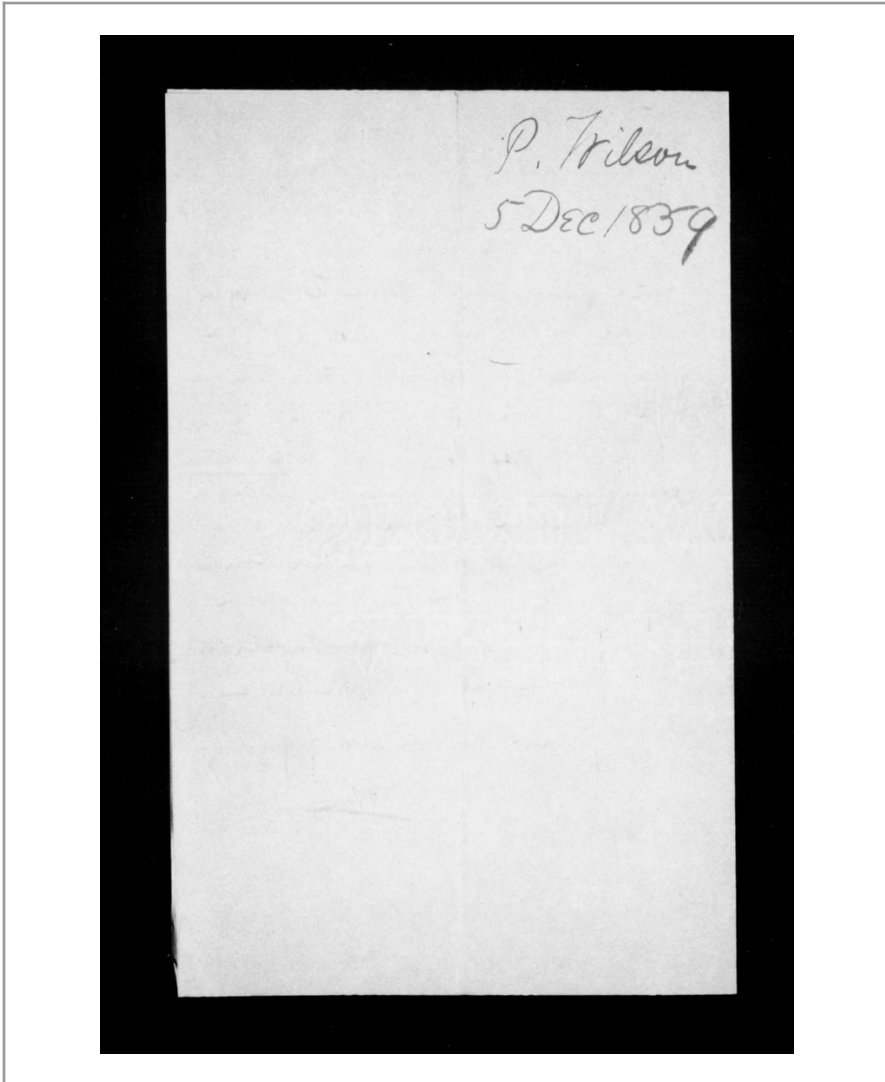
