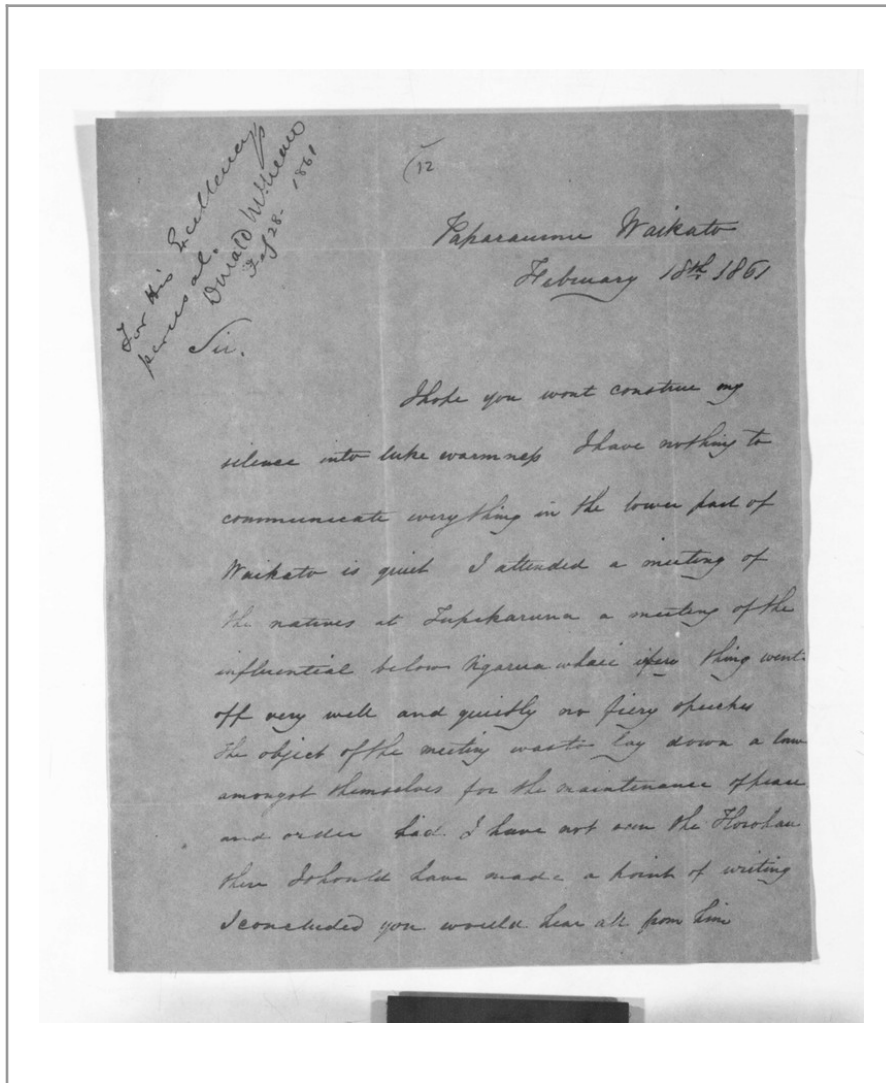

Agathineta to the lower Waikato Chiefs begging

way collecting flats and what ever he could get
to forward

I shall not hesitate to trouble you
