

 To Mr. W. Seal,
 This is to inform you
 that we have returned (on our way)
 to Taupo - this month. - We have
 heard of the disturbances at Taupo
 but they are waiting for our return.
 You too - have already perhaps heard
 of these affairs - It has given
 much concern - After we have
 reached home, we will then
 communicate to you. I thought
 this - by friend - I am very anxious
 to have a piece of land at Rangitikei
 If you approve of this. Sent word to
 N. Jackson & W. Kemp - and they
 will communicate with me.
 Signed, Herekikie.
 Herekikie was on his way to Taupo
 by telegram from W. & Remond & requested
 some Rations for the Journey which I
 procured for him. J. T. Kemp.
